We would like to invite your club to this year's Cambridgeshire County 4 weapon team event on Sunday the 4<sup>th</sup> of September. This is a fun event, each team consisting of a female foilist, a male foilist, an epeeist and a sabreur. Teams fence up to 40 points in a relay. The order in which team members fence is drawn out of a hat at the start of each round. I am sorry for the delay this year. Please note we also have a **change of venue for this year**.

To ensure the competition runs smoothly we would like clubs to let us know **as early as possible** whether they will be sending a team/s or not. Initially clubs will be limited to two teams. If you would like to enter a third team please contact me and if there are spare places we will let you know. The competition is being held at One Leisure **St. Ives** which has good changing facilities and a range of food is available in the bar. - Membership of the BFA at a suitable level is required.
- Lamé bibs are required for foil.
- Electric equipment will be used throughout.
- All clothing and equipment must conform to the B.F.A. regulations. (It may be possible to borrow some equipment, please ask in advance).
- Competitors without proper equipment may not be able to fence on the day
- All competitors should arrive in good time
- The C.F.A. accepts no responsibility for damage or loss to persons or their property
- B.F.A. rules will apply with the proviso of the organisers discretion
- Medals will be awarded to the first three placed teams
- Refreshments are available on the premises.

Please return forms to arrive before Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> of August to the address below. You can email the details if you prefer but fencers under the age of 18 will still need a signed form on the day.

Competitors must be 13 yrs of age or over on the day of the competition.
